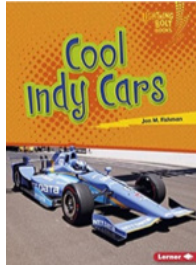


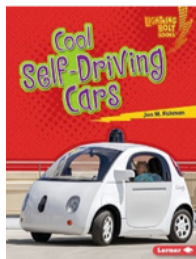

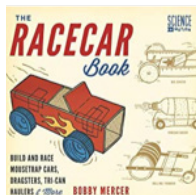
Sports Cars by Thomas K. Adamson (Interest Level Grades 2-3)
