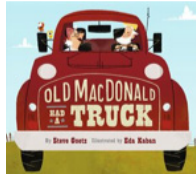


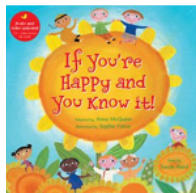

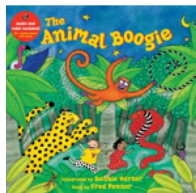
Old MacDonald Had A Truck by Steve Goetz, Eda Kaban

Beloved machines—the excavator, dump truck, bulldozer, and more—will have the vehicle-obsessed of all ages reading and singing along.



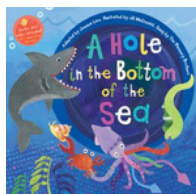
If You're Happy and You Know It by Anna McQuinn

Meet children from thirty-six cultures as you sing your way through this joyful book. You'll also learn to say "hello" in each of their languages.



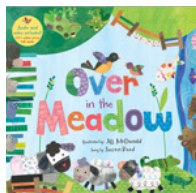
The Animal Boogie by Debbie Harter
