



5 Senses Poems



Supplies:

paper, any art supplies, your imagination

Directions:

Pick a topic for your poem. It can be anything you like (ice cream, your pet, camping, etc) but make sure it is something you know well.

Divide a piece of scratch paper into five columns.

Label them see, hear, smell, touch and taste.

Begin filling in the columns with things about your topic.

Look your words over to find the ones you like best.

The first five lines of your poem will begin with "I see," "I hear," "I smell," etc. followed by words from your lists.

Your last line could name the topic or could say "I love" and name your topic.
