

# Collage Poems



## **Supplies:**

- Junk mail or old magazines and newspapers that your adult allows you to cut up (Be sure to ask first!)
- Background paper
- Glue or glue stick
- Any art supplies

## **Directions:**

- Look through your printed materials to find interesting words.
- Cut out the ones you like.
- Arrange the words on your background paper to make a poem.
- You may need to add some handwritten words to make your poem say exactly what you want it to say.
- When you like the arrangement, glue your words down.
- Illustrate your poem.
