The Shape Game

Here are some variations of The Shape Game that you can try with a friend or by yourself!

The most simple version is to have someone draw a shape on a piece of paper. Look at the shape and see if you can think of something to make it into. You can each make a shape and trade papers!



Try the same thing but with a scribble to start with!

You can also tear a shape and use that as your starter. Look at it from different angles to see what you can make it into. When you are ready, glue it down and draw the rest of the picture.

Another version is to glue down part of a picture from the newspaper or a magazine (Ask before cutting any pictures!) and draw the rest of the picture!

You can also place a 3D object (leaf, bottle cap, paper clip, etc,) on your paper and make your drawing around that.

You can also use letters or numbers as a starting point for your drawing. Write a large number or letter on your paper. See if you can turn it into a picture.
