Let's try writing acrostic poems about people.

Choose a person to write about. It can be yourself, a friend or family member, or any person you know a lot about.

Write the person's name downward in the boxes on the left side of the paper below.

Turn the paper over and use the back to write words and phrases about the person.

Now look at what you have written to see what phrases you can use that begin with one of the letters of your person's name. You may have to add or take away words to make it work. For example, my name doesn't have a C but I could say "Likes cherries" for the L in my name.

Use the space below for your rough draft. When you are happy with your words, write them on a clean sheet of paper and illustrate it if you like.
