#### by Kelly DiPucchio (E DIPUCCHI)



Robug tries to obey when Jake instructs it to "Fix this mess!" but somehow manages to make things worse.




# Geeger the Robot Goes to School by Jarrett Lerner (J LERNER)


## Love, Z by Jessie Sima (E SIMA)
