
Based on a Book Art Activity


Read one of these books and make a piece of art inspired by it.



Glue or trace a stick to your paper and draw a picture around it like the drawings in the book. You could also use a pipe cleaner or a piece of paper or a craft stick.



Start with any number of dots on your paper and make a picture with the dots. Will your dots be eyes or wheels or something else? You can use dot stickers or paper circles or you can draw dots. You can even stamp dots with your fingers if you want.



For this activity, you just need a square of paper and any art supplies you choose. You can cut, fold, tear or crumple your square and use the pieces to make a new picture.
